

How to make fabric envelope bag for transferring fibre art piece

1. Cut piece of fabric 18 x 48" (or piece together from scraps)
2. On short side, fold over ¼" and press right side to wrong side. Fold over again and press. Stitch for hem. Repeat on other short side.
3. Make fold 3 ½" from short side top. Right sides together.
4. Then fold in half lengthwise-right sides together; keeping the 3 ½" fold inside (wrong side will be showing on the 3 ½" piece).
5. Stitch ¼" seam along each long side, with fold inside.
6. Turn right side out. Poking out corners. Flip the flap over to the front – to create envelope closure. Press.
7. Place label on non flap side of bag; bottom right hand corner. 1" from side and bottom of bag.

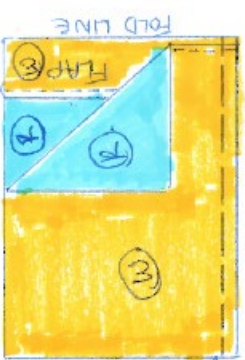
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WRONG SIDE (W)
